- utilise the hierarchy of controls to minimise risk to the workforce and the public

The Company's **environmental and energy objectives** are to:

- protect the environment and prevent pollution wherever possible
- increase the percentage of recycled materials used in our construction activities and reduce the consumption of natural resources
- reduce the amount of waste produced by utilising new methods of construction
- reduce the amount of waste to landfill by further improvements in segregation and reclamation
- reduce the production of dust by adopting alternative processes
- improve the efficiencies of plant and equipment to reduce noise and vibration
- reduce transport distances and emissions by sourcing materials, labour and supply chain partners that are local to our construction sites
- measure, monitor and reduce water, gas, fuel and electricity consumption
- monitor our carbon footprint in accordance with the DEFRA guide scope 1 and 2 to measure and report our greenhouse gas emissions.
- be as energy efficient as possible and continually improve energy performance
- ensure where energy efficient products, services and design have been identified, that these improvements will be considered.

The Company's **quality objectives** are to:

- fully comply with quality standards, codes of practice and Company procedures
- ensure continued compliance with the requirements of ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 50001, ISO 45001 as well as other standards the Company subscribes to.
